About **Risks** mark an **X** on the right expression:

Something that has the potential to cause harm.	
The probability that damage will be done.	
Something that is impossible to happen.	

Type **H** for **HAZARDS** and **R** for **RISKS** on the following expressions:

Rocking on a chair	
To be in pain after hours of sitting in a bad position.	
Cords or cables on the floor.	
Boxes and files stacked too high.	
Being hit by an object for not evacuating during an earthquake.	
Boxes or other objects blocking the exits.	
Computers or printers placed on the floor instead of on a table.	
To get an electric shock for touching an electrical outlet with wet hands.	
Placing the garbage bin or other objects in the middle of the class.	
Carrying too many things that block your sight.	
Getting the screen light too close to the eyes.
