In the world of hospitality and tourism, there are various job roles that play a crucial role in ensuring guests have a pleasant experience. Let's take a closer look at some of these roles:

Primary duties: They are responsible for greeting and assisting hotel guests. They communicate with other staff members to provide for the guests' needs, book hotel visits, check guests in and out, answer phone calls and provide information about hotel amenities and policies.

Primary duties: They work with visitors or tourists who are interested in seeing local attractions. They may have a set route they follow, along with interesting facts and stories about the attractions they show. Primary duties: They are responsible for greeting customers, making drinks and serving customers their orders. Depending on the company, they may also entertain guests and keep the bar well-stocked and maintained. Some of them also develop new or custom recipes for events.
