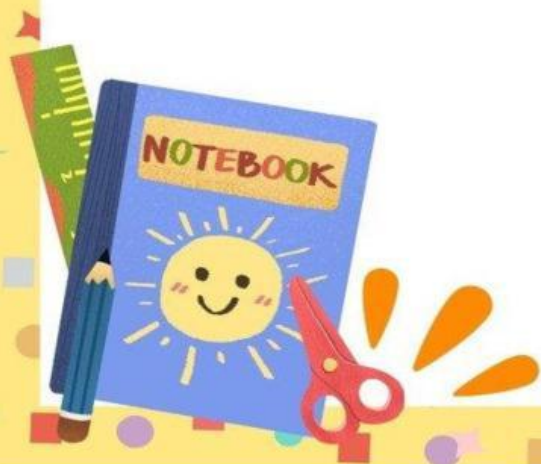

DEFINITION

A noun is a word that names a person, place, thing, or idea

TYPES OF NOUNS

Common nouns	Proper nouns	Abstract nouns	Concrete nouns
General names for people, places, things or ideas	specific names of people, places, or things.	names for ideas, qualities, or emotions	names for things that can be seen, touched, or experienced through the senses
Dog, city, book	Mary, Paris, Coca-cola	Love, courage, freedom	Table, tree, bicycle
