1 focus group

a the study of human society and social relationships, including anthropology, sociology, psychology, economics, and political science

2 questionnaire

b research methods that involve collecting numerical data and analyzing it using statistical methods to draw conclusions

3 survey

c a scientific procedure carried out to test a hypothesis or demonstrate a known fact by observing and measuring the results

4 participate observation

d a research method that involves collecting data from a group of people through questionnaires, interviews, or online forms to gather information about their opinions or experiences

5 social science

e a research method in which the observer remains separate from the group being observed and records observations without participating in the activities of the group

6 quantitative methods

f a research method in which the observer becomes part of the group being observed and records observations while participating in the activities of the group

7 qualitative methods

g research methods that involve collecting non-numerical data such as words, images, or observations, and analyzing it to identify patterns, themes, or meanings

8 interviews

h a formal or informal conversation between two people, where one person asks questions and the other person answers them

9 non-participant observation

i a set of written or printed questions with a choice of answers, designed to gather information on a particular topic or subject

10 experiment

j a research method that involves bringing together a small group of people to discuss a product, service, or idea, and gathering their opinions and feedback.
