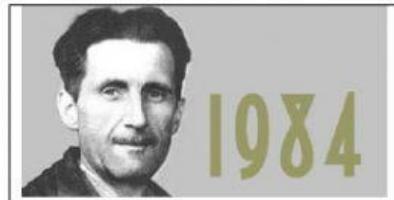

Muse alternative rock band songwriter and singer Matt Bellamy was inspired by *Nineteen Eighty-Four: A Novel*, often published as **1984**, a dystopian social science fiction novel by English novelist George Orwell, published on 8 June 1949, when he wrote this song. Although this emblematic novel is best known for the political criticism of totalitarian regimes, he focused on the romance in the novel between the main character, Winston Smith, and Julia, who falls in love with him, under the menacing eye of Big Brother. The Thought Police hunt dissidents and torture the lovers forcing them to submit to the Regime.
