Form: Some indefinite pronouns refer to people. They start with any, some, no or every. They end with the words body or one. Usage: Indefinite pronouns are substitute words for people that cannot be or simply are not wanted to be named. So, they can be used instead of them. They are in the singular even if they denote several people. Examples: • Is there anybody under the bed? • Yes, there's somebody there. • Is there anybody on the stairs? • No, there isn't anybody there. • Is there anybody in the car? • No, there isn't anybody there. • Is there anybody behind the tree? • Yes, there's somebody there. • Everybody is jumping. • Nobody is laughing.
