



The blood that returns to the heart, flows into the right atrium through the vena cava.

Blood from the left ventricle into the aorta ejected.

The blood that returns to the heart, is going in the right atrium.

The blood goes to the lungs through the pulmonary artery.

Oxygenated blood returns from the lungs.

Blood from the right ventricle into the pulmonary artery is pushed.

Valves allow blood to flow in only one direction.

The largest of veins - inferior vena cava.

The largest artery - Aorta.
