### The Ways of Forming Adverbs in English

|   | Adjective                                | Adverbs                                |
|---|--|--|
| 1. adjective + <b>ly</b>  | slow<br>quick<br>rare<br><b>but true</b> | slowly<br>quickly<br>rarely<br>truly   |
| 2. adjectives ending in <b>ic</b> + <b>ally</b>                                       | tragic<br>dramatic<br><b>but public</b>  | tragically<br>dramatically<br>publicly |
| 3. adjectives ending in <b>le</b> change «e» in «y»                                   | simple<br>terrible                       | simply<br>terribly                     |
| 4. adjectives ending in consonant with «y» drop «y» and add <b>ily</b>                | easy<br>happy                            | easily<br>happily                      |
| 5. adjectives ending in <b>ly</b> form their adverbs with <b>in a ... way/ manner</b> | friendly<br>silly                        | in a friendly way<br>in a silly manner |
| 6. Main irregular adverbs   | good<br>fast<br>hard<br>early<br>late    | well<br>fast<br>hard<br>early<br>late  |
