I went to The Grand Canyon, where I learned The Grand Canyon is so gigantic that it can have all mankind there together. I really only can compare this to the Chinese subway at rush hours...

I went to Canada; there I was surprised to know that The Moosehead Brewery in Saint John, New Brunswick turns out 1,642 bottles of beer per minute! I do believe they love beer more than I do. From Canada I went to Australia. One of the things that surprised me more was to know it's absolutely huge!
