

Phrasal Verbs

be after:	(tr) 1) want, try to gain, 2) chase
be against:	(tr) oppose (opp: be for)
be in for:	(tr) expect sth (usu bad)
be off:	(tr) 1) not want/like any more, 2) be absent (from school, work, etc)
be on:	(tr) be shown (on TV, at the cinema, etc)
be out of:	(tr) not have sth; lack
be over:	(int) come to an end
be up:	(int) 1) be awake and out of bed, 2) stay awake at night, 3) be wrong or unusual
break down:	(int) 1) stop working, 2) lose control of feelings, 3) fail
break in (int)/	
break into (tr):	1) enter by force, 2) interrupt
break out:	(int) 1) begin suddenly (of war, fire, etc)
	BUT: a storm breaks, 2) escape
break up:	(int) 1) stop for holidays (of schools, etc), 2) separate; split up
