1. A group of houses and other buildings that is smaller than a town, usually in the countryside. \_\_\_\_\_
2. A group of shops with a common area for cars to park.

3. An area of approximately square-shaped land in a city or a town, often including the buildings that surround it.

4. One of a set of red, yellow, and green lights that control the movement of vehicles, usually at a point where two or more roads join. \_\_\_\_\_
5. Continuing in one direction without bending or curving.

6. A place where three or more roads join and traffic must go around a circular area in the middle, rather than straight across. \_\_\_\_\_
7. A large town. \_\_\_\_\_
8. A place on a road, especially one where there is a lot of traffic, across which wide, black and white lines are painted, and at which vehicles must stop to allow people to walk across the road. \_\_\_\_\_
9. A building where you can play different sports. \_\_\_\_\_
10. A place where people live and work, containing many houses, shops, places of work, places of entertainment, etc., and usually larger than a village but smaller than a city.
