Contractions with 'Be' Verbs

Statements

Affirmative

NOTE: Contractions are **NOT** used with the past forms of the 'Be' verb (was & were).

| ● I am late. | I <u>m</u> late. | I <u>m not</u> late. | |
| ● You are late. | You're late. | You're not late. | OR You aren't late. |
| ● He is late. | He's late. | He's not late. | OR He isn't late. |
| ● She is late. | She's late. | She's not late. | OR She isn't late. |
| ● It is late. | It's late. | It's not late. | OR It isn't late. |
| ● We are late. | We're late. | We're not late. | OR We aren't late. |
| ● They are late. | They're late. | They're not late. | OR They aren't late. |

- **Contractions** are commonly used in spoken English, but less commonly used in written English. They are often be found in 'friendly' texts, (such as e-mails to friends) but not in 'formal' texts (such as business letters, cover letters and job resumes).



NOTE:
The contraction of
"I am not" is "I'm not"
BUT NEVER "Imn't"

Yes, we **are**. / No, we **aren't**.

Yes, we **are**. / No, we **aren't**.

Yes, they **are**. / No, they **aren't**.

Woman: Yes, it is open 24 hours.

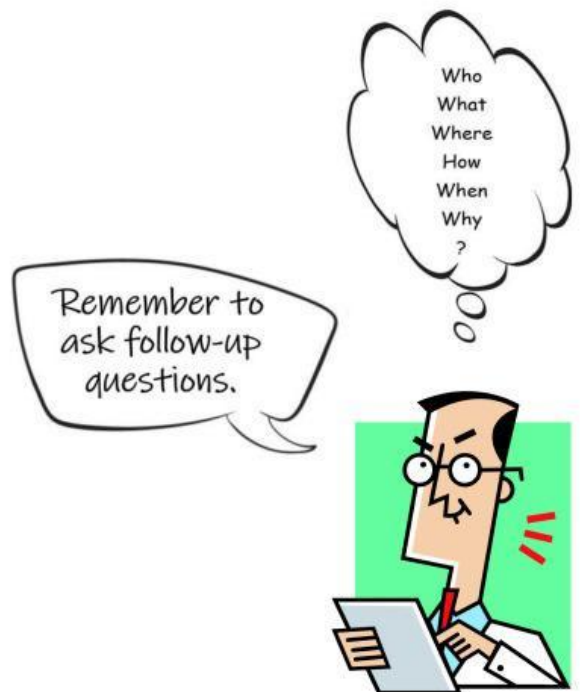
