Long adjectives /adverbs	exciting clearly	more exciting (than) more clearly (than)	the most exciting the most clearly
Irregular adjectives /adverbs	good/well bad much/many little far	better (than) worse (than) more (than) less (than) further (than) / farther (than)	the best the worst the most the least the furthest / The farthest
