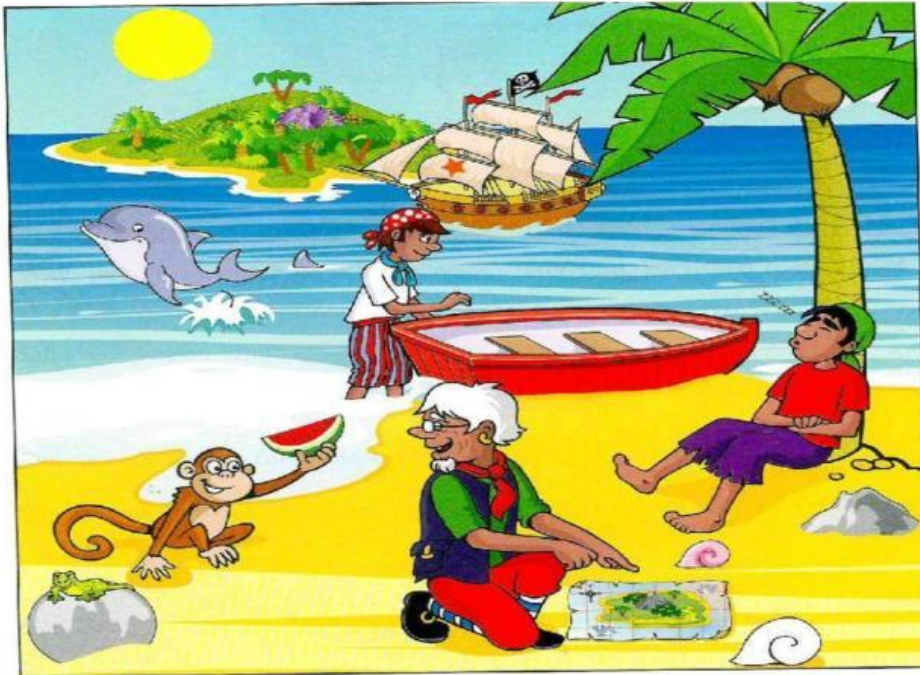
"Goodbye, Mr Sam," Jane said very quietly. "Thank you again for the beautiful scarf."
