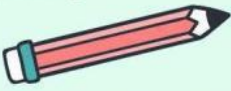

A/AN	THE	No article
- when mentioning sth or sb for the 1st time or talking about sth in general <i>A man was standing outside my house.</i> - we use AN in front of a vowel or a vowel-like sound <i>an apple, an hour</i> 	- when mentioning sth or sb for the 2nd time or talking about sth specific <i>The man was dressed in a black coat.</i> - with church, school, university, hospital if people are not normally there <i>I went to the school to attend a parent-teacher meeting.</i> 	- with words bed, church, school, prison, university when they are used for their primary purpose <i>Michael is in bed.</i> <i>My children go to school every day.</i> <i>My friend is sick and is in hospital.</i> - with more abstract expressions to/at sea, in/out of work <i>He is at work.</i> <i>She is out of town.</i>
