




Where was the telephone?	No, he wasn't asleep.

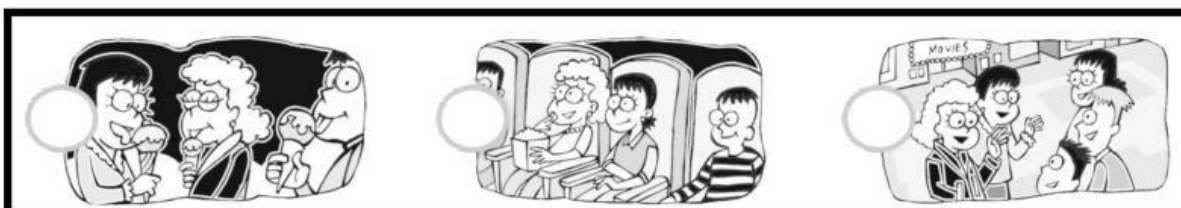
