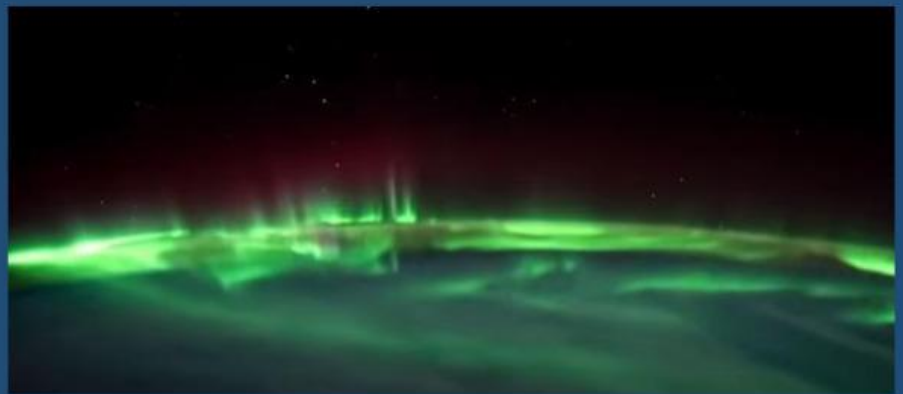

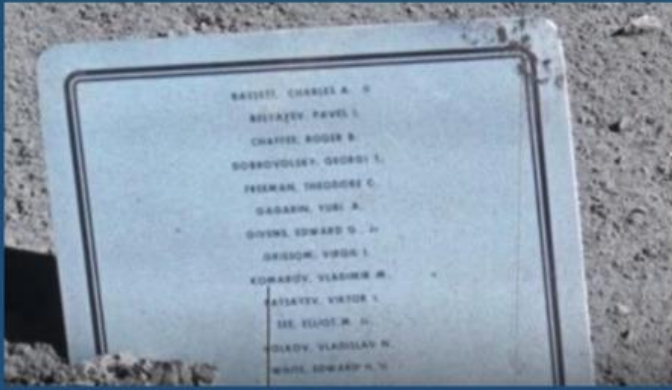
The inventor of the Super Soaker - Lonnie Johnson - was a NASA _____ who helped develop the US Air Force's stealth _____.
