FROM HOME TO MOVIE SET

Here at "Back Home" we usually write about, well, homes. But houses aren't the only places that get filled with furniture and décor. We recently spoke to set decorator Pat Sasaki about what it's like to turn a Hollywood set into a dream home.

Pat, most people don't really think about how much work it takes to make all those movie scenes look so real. Until recently, I didn't even know movie sets had decorators. How did you become one?

Pat: Well, I started as an interior decorator, choosing furniture and art for people's homes, helping them select paint colors and material for their floor—all the same things you write about in your magazine. I was working for a company in Los Angeles, and we got a job decorating the house of well-known actor. He liked our work so much, we were hired to work on his next movie.

So, is decorating a movie set just like decorating a house?

Pat: In a lot of ways it can be similar to decorating a home, yes, especially when a lot of the movie is filmed in homes. But it's more than that. When I was decorating homes, I didn't have to place food, personal items, or dirty clothes, but on a movie set, I do. I even have to think about what kind of trash might be on a counter—like an empty cookie package or old pieces of mail. Those are the details that make a movie set look real.

Is it hard to find all the items you need for a set?

Pat: Sometimes. Last year, I brought in all of these phones for a science fiction movie—modern ones from companies that wanted their two minutes of movie fame—but the director didn't like any of them. We must have gone through at least 20 different phones. Then I remembered this strange-looking telephone my mom used to have when I was young. So I drove the two hours to my mom's house and searched through her attic—it was still there! I brought it to the set and the director absolutely loved it!

What's the best part of your job?

Pat: It's definitely the shopping, especially when we're shooting in another country. I love going to the antique markets in Belgium and Germany to look for items for movies. Some of them are so big that you have to ride a bicycle to get around. Of course, I usually pick up a little something for myself, too!
