

Task: Creating a Mini-Story Using Present Continuous

Objective: To demonstrate an understanding of the Present Continuous tense by creating a mini-story in which characters are engaged in various ongoing actions.

Instructions for Students:

1. You will create a short mini-story using the Present Continuous tense to describe ongoing actions.
2. Start by introducing the characters and setting the scene.
3. Describe what the characters are doing at the moment using the Present Continuous tense.
4. Try to include at least three different actions in your mini-story, and make sure they are ongoing actions (happening right now).
5. Finally, wrap up the story with a concluding sentence.

Example:

Sarah and Tom are at the park. Sarah is reading a book under the tree, and Tom is playing with his dog. Sarah isn't talking to anyone because she's so engrossed in her book. Tom is laughing as he throws a ball for his dog. It's a lovely, peaceful day at the park.
