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16. I wish I had gone to that party but I couldn't because of my parents.

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17. It is not possible that you are going to the cinema tomorrow because it is closed.

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18. It was possible that your cousin was at the party yesterday.

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19. They are certain that the fire was provoked.

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20. It wasn't obligatory to go to the school yesterday because there was a strike.

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
