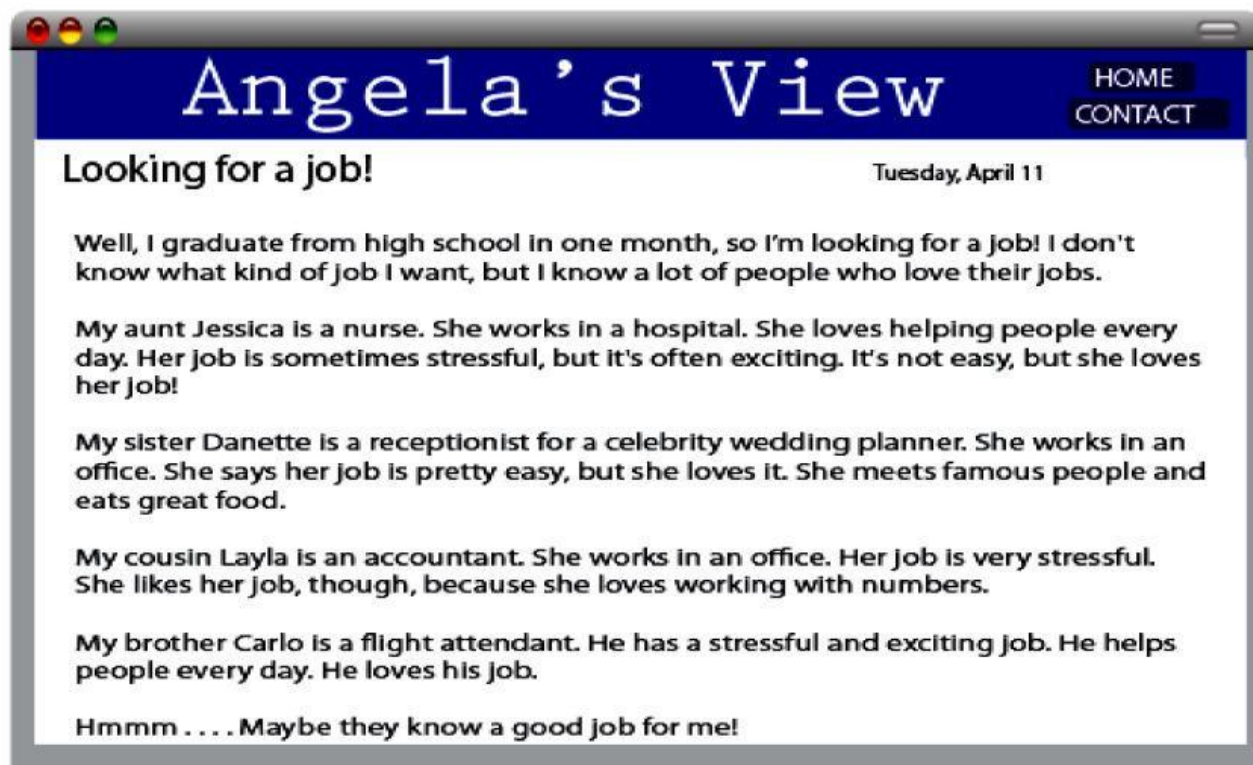

Well, I graduate from high school in one month, so I'm looking for a job! I don't know what kind of job I want, but I know a lot of people who love their jobs.

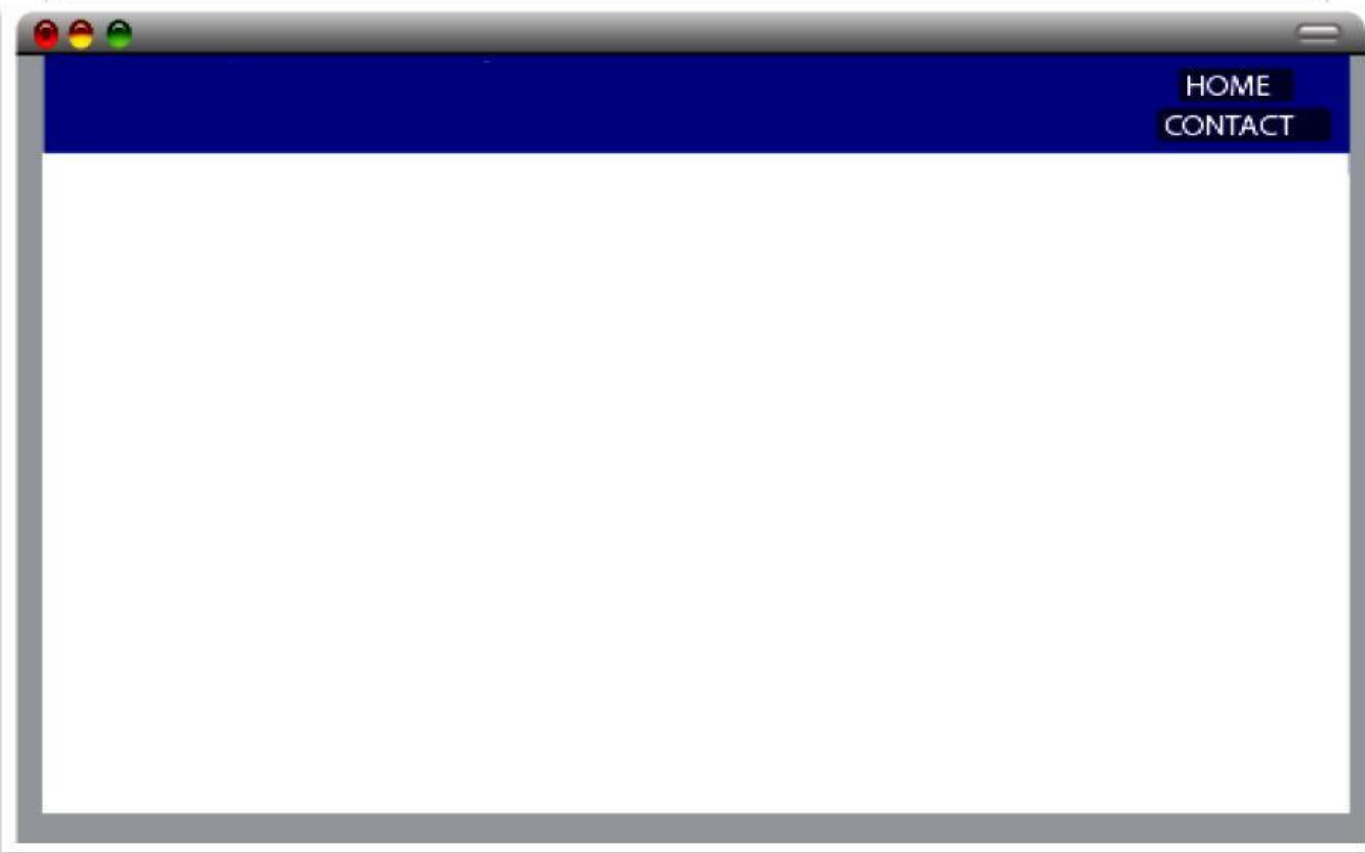

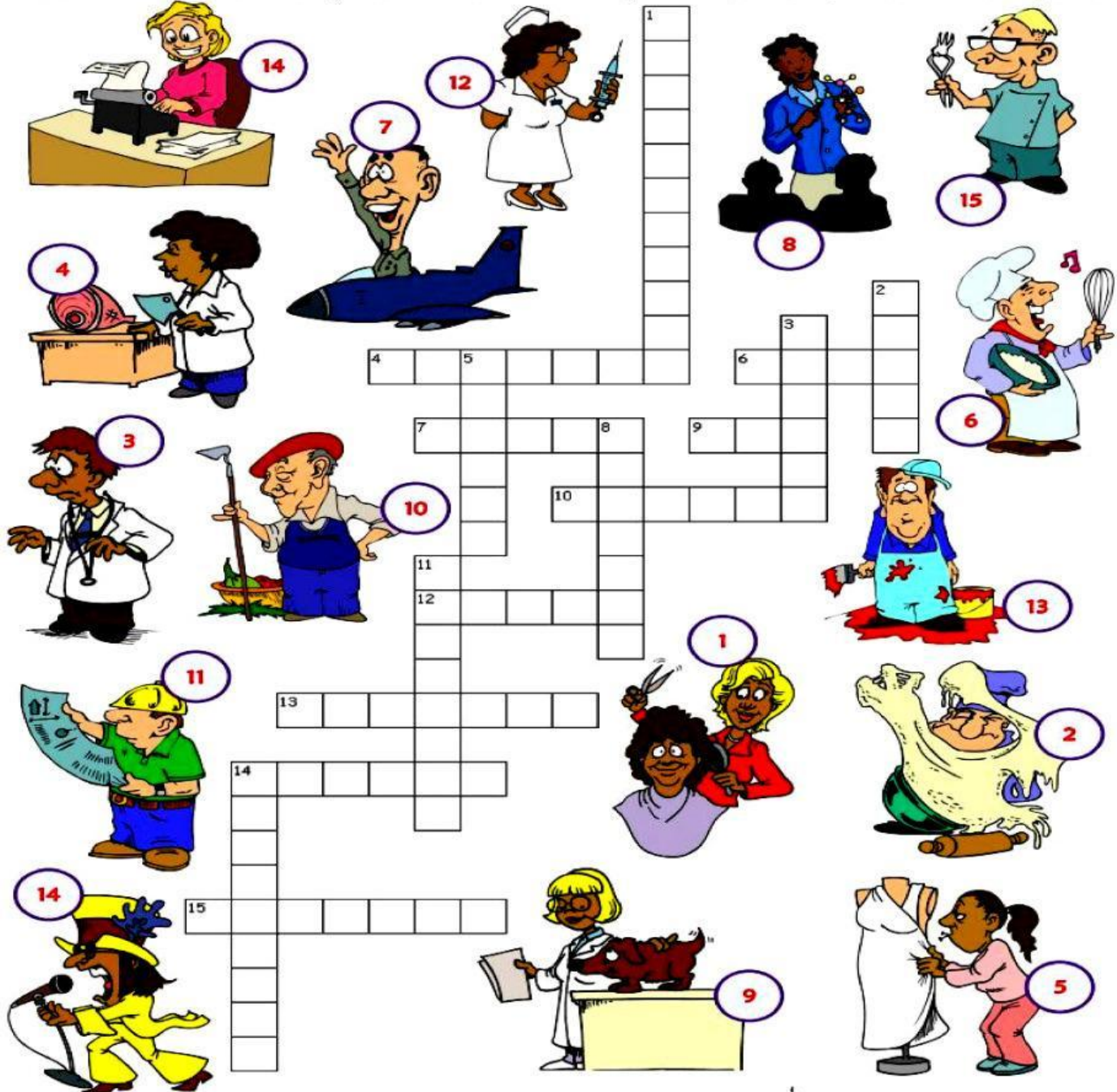

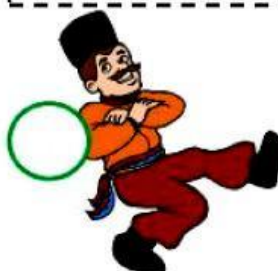
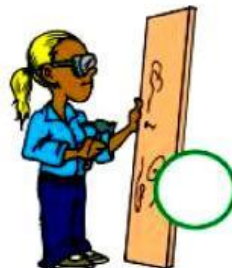
