Halloween, also **(KNOW)** _____ as All Hallows' Eve, is believed to have originated from ancient Celtic festivals. The Celts, who lived over 2,000 years ago in the area that **(CALL)** _____ presently Ireland, the United Kingdom, and northern France, celebrated their new year on November 1. They believed that on the night before the new year, October 31, the boundary between the living and the dead was blurred, and the dead **(COME)** _____ back to earth to cause havoc.

To ward off these spirits, the Celts would light bonfires and wear costumes and masks. They also offered food and sacrifices to appease the spirits. This festival was known as Samhain, **(MEAN)** _____ "summer's end" in Gaelic.

When the Roman Empire conquered Celtic lands in the 1st century AD, they combined Samhain with **(THEY)** _____ own festival honoring Pomona, the Roman goddess of fruit and trees. This is believed to be where the tradition of bobbing for apples originated.

As Christianity spread throughout the Roman Empire, the church attempted to replace pagan festivals with Christian holidays. In the 7th century, Pope Boniface IV established All Saints' Day on November 1 to honor saints and martyrs, which was later expanded to include all saints by Pope Gregory III in the **(EIGHT)** _____ century. The evening before was known as All Hallows' Eve, eventually becoming Halloween.

Several Halloween traditions evolved over the centuries. In medieval Europe, a practice called "souling" emerged, where poor people **(GO)** _____ door-to-door offering prayers for the dead in exchange for food. This eventually evolved into the modern practice of trick-or-treating.

The influx of Irish and Scottish immigrants to the United States in the 19th century brought their Halloween traditions with them. The holiday became more community-centered and focused on parties, games, and costumes. Additionally, Irish immigrants **(BRING)** _____ the tradition of carving turnips and later pumpkins into jack-o'-lanterns, which were originally used to ward off evil spirits.

Halloween continued to evolve and grow in popularity throughout the 20th century. Today, it **(CELEBRATE)** _____ by people of all ages around the world with activities such as costume parties, haunted houses, pumpkin carving, and trick-or-treating. It has become a cultural phenomenon, blending elements of ancient Celtic beliefs, Roman traditions, and Christian customs to create a unique and widely celebrated holiday.
