"The" is used to indicate a particular person(s) or thing(s) in the case of common nouns.	I saw the boy shopping.
Names of oceans, gulfs, seas, and rivers: the Pacific, the Atlantic, the Coral Sea, the Timor Sea, the Persian Gulf, the Nile, the Murray River, the Darling River, etc.	
Names of countries with united states or islands: the United States of America (the USA), the UK, the UAE, the Philippines, etc.	
When we talk about a particular group of things , we use <i>the</i> .	We went to the zoo and saw the kangaroos

Zero article

No article is used with proper nouns , mass nouns where the reference is indefinite, or plural count nouns where the reference is indefinite.	Her name is Jessica.
Mass nouns are those that cannot be counted, such as "air" or "sadness". They also are used with no article.	Clean water is important for the environment.
When we talk about things in general, we normally use a plural or uncountable noun with no article.	Birds eat worms. Water freezes at 0°C. Children need a lot of sleep
