

## MATCH THE MEANING

**LOOKING FORWARD TO**

to fix something or secure something somewhere from the top of the object

**HANG UP**

to descend from a higher level

**BUMP INTO**

to meet someone by chance

**COME DOWN**

to wait for something with pleasure

**WRAP UP**

to sing a song with someone who is already singing

**SING ALONG**

to cover something completely by putting paper or other material around it

**GOOD THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKETS**

This idiom is used when someone accepts a situation that will have a bad outcome for them.

**DECK THE HALLS**

it means they are overly dressed.

**LIKE TURKEY VOTING FOR CHRISTMAS**

We should not judge a package by its size. The size of something does not indicate its value.

**LIT UP LIKE A CHRISTMAS TREE**

This idiom means that the success of something can only be judged by testing or using it.
