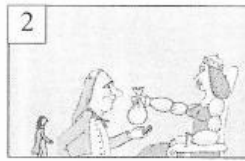

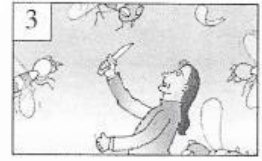

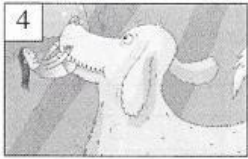

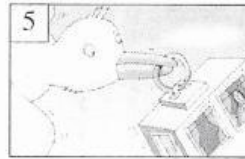

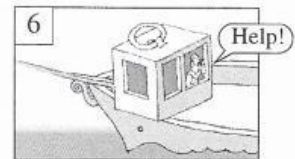
Gulliver is killing / is helping the insects.
