

Beitou Hot Spring Museum



The Beitou Hot Spring Museum was built in 1913 and used to be a public bathhouse. It was one of the largest hot spring baths in East Asia.

Today, it is a museum where you can learn about hot springs and the history of Beitou. Many tourists visit the



museum to see how people bathed in the bathhouses.



Tourists also love the stained-glass windows and the Japanese tatami floor to sit on.



Because the building is so old, visitors must take off their shoes when they go in. It is open from 10 am to 6 pm. Remember, you can't take any food or drinks into the museum.
