Amelia the Good Friend

Arnold and Amelia are geese, which are like large ducks, from a bird park in Massachusetts, USA. They have been living together on the same lake with several other geese for a few months.

One day, staff at the park noticed that Arnold had difficulty walking. He could swim and fly perfectly well but he couldn't put his foot down on the ground. When Doctor Patel opened the door, Amelia came inside and moved close to Arnold to look after him.

Unfortunately, Arnold couldn't return to the lake immediately as his foot needed four weeks to get better. Every morning, Amelia visited him. After five days, Doctor Patel put a plastic boot on Arnold's foot so he could spend a few hours on the grass outside. When Arnold went outside, Amelia joined him. They had lunch together every day.

Now Arnold's foot is better, and he is back in the water with Amelia. Doctor Patel knows that soon they will fly away to another country, but hopes they will come back.
