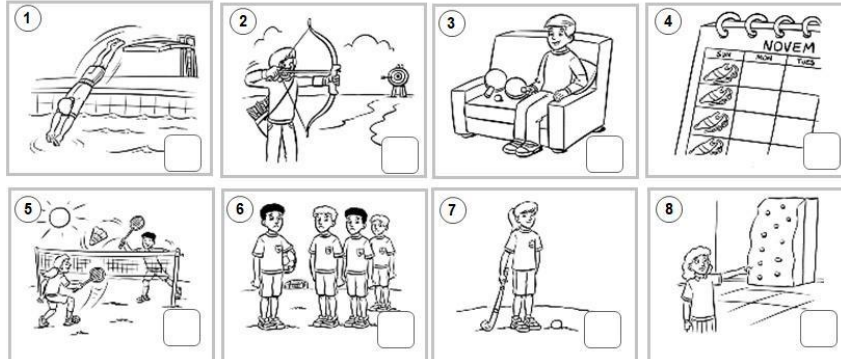

Present continuous	I'm / You're / We're / They're	going	trampolining	on Fridays.
