

Direct Objects

Type the action verb in the first box and type the direct object in the second box. Remember a direct object receives the action of the verb. **Find the action verb first. Then ask yourself what or who is receiving the action.

Ex: Justin watched a movie last night. (Watched what?) Direct object: movie
