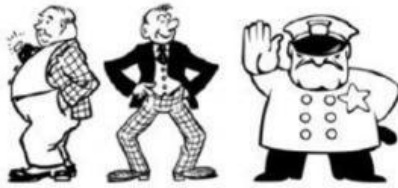


# 1. Use the comparative or the superlative form.



James

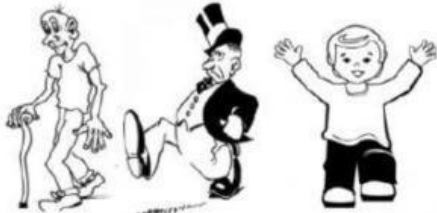
Tom

Cheetah

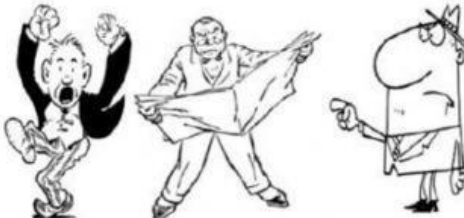
Turtle

Sam

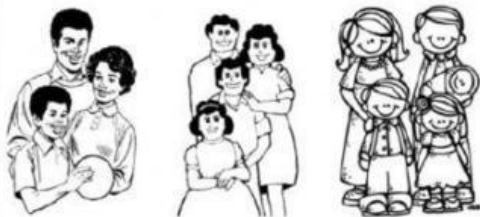
Tom
