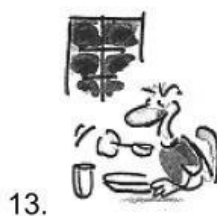

My Dad comes back home around six. He is **usually** tired after work, but he **often** plays with me. He likes my train



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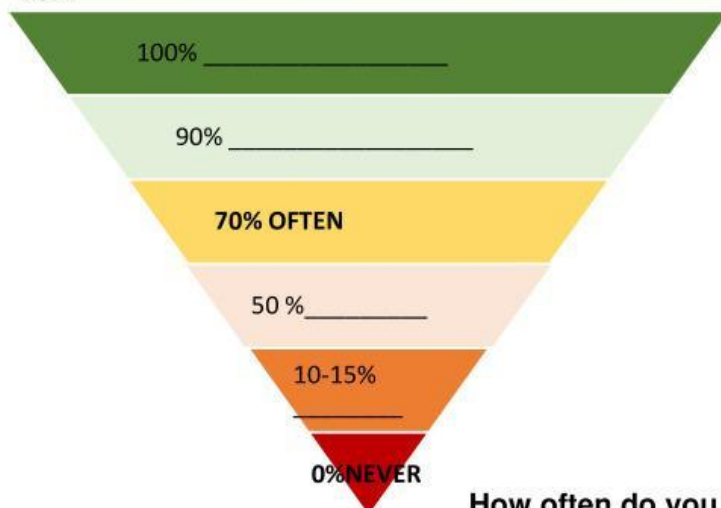
