Change the following sentences from zero conditional to first conditional. Maintain the order of the original sentence and don't use *then*

1. If you're in a hurry, a taxi to the airport is faster than a hotel shuttle.
2. Hotel guests get a free breakfast if they reserve a suite.
3. If your hotel has a shuttle, getting there from the airport is very convenient.
4. If you travel overseas, you get the best exchange rate at an ATM.
5. The hotel charges you at check out if you take something from the minibar.
6. The front desk calls you in the morning if you want wake-up service.
7. If you leave too soon, you miss the fireworks at the end of the party.
8. If we don't invite them to dinner every month, they never visit us.

9. If you freeze water, it becomes solid.

10. If you close the blinds during the day, the room gets too dark.
