

POSSESSIVES!

In English, we can modify an object by placing a possessive adjective and a possessive pronoun. Let's see the differences:



PERSONAL PRONOUN	POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE	POSSESSIVE PRONOUN
I	MY	MINE

When we want to express possession of an object the uses of both possessives will vary in structure. For example:



1. This is **my** book. 1. That is **your** book.
2. This book is **mine**. 2. That book is **yours**.

We use the pronoun **IT** to refer to objects and other living beings that are not human

WE CAN ALSO EXPRESS POSSESSION USING THE POSSESSIVE 'S :

FOR EXAMPLE:

THIS IS THE DOG'S COLLAR // THIS IS MY MOTHER'S HOUSE // THAT IS MY FRIEND'S HOUSE.

WE ONLY ADD THE ' WHEN THE WORD ENDS WITH THE LETTER S. FOR EXAMPLE:

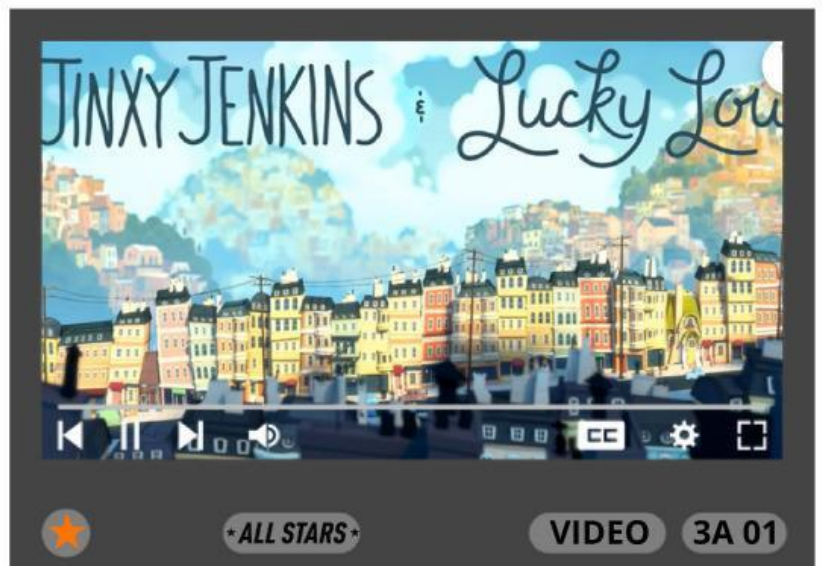
THAT IS LUCAS' BROTHER // THEY ARE MY FRIENDS' PARENTS.
