Growing with Values - Honesty

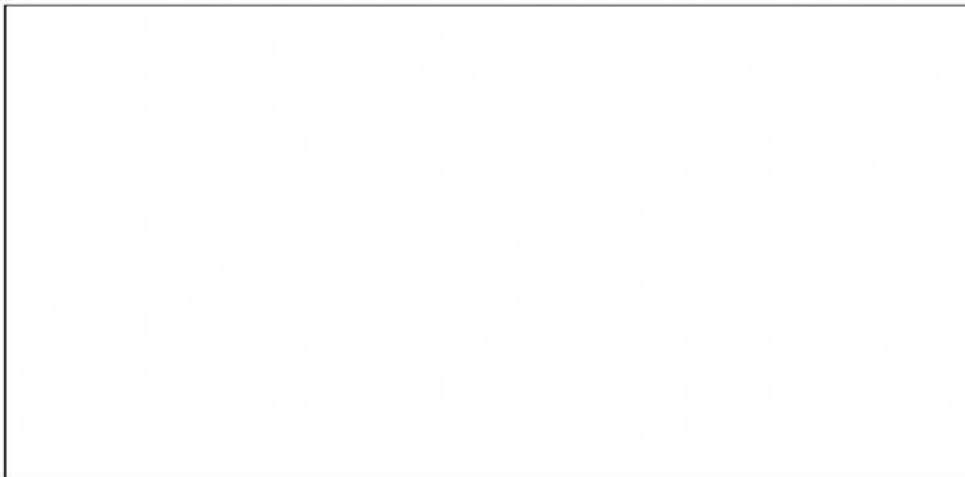


Honesty is one of the best values individuals can nurture in their lives. Honest means free of deceit; truth, sincere. When individuals are honest, people trust and respect them more. They also demonstrate to God that they value His truth. Deuteronomy 5:20 commands, "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour."

Dishonesty was displayed by a number of biblical characters. Ananias and Sapphira lied to the Holy Spirit (Acts 5) and both were struck down dead. David lied to Achish, the Philistine ruler, by pretending to be loyal to him. (1 Samuel 27-29). God rescued him although he didn't deserve it.

Being honest requires a choice: to tell truth or lies. With choices come positive or negative reactions. Dishonesty can result in people being hurt, individuals being expelled from school and people being sent to jail.
