2. There are 55 apples in a basket. If 22 apples are green and the rest are red, how many more red apples are there than green apples?
3. Alex has 78 toy cars. He gives 35 toy cars to his cousin. How many fewer toy cars does Alex have than he started with?
4. In a garden, there are 60 tulips and 42 daisies. How many more tulips are there than daisies?
5. Samantha has 95 stickers. She buys 20 more stickers at the store. How many stickers does she have now, and how many more stickers does she have than she originally had?
6. A bakery had 120 cookies. If they sold 65 cookies and then baked 30 more, how many fewer cookies do they have than when they started?
7. There are 150 students in a school. If 40 students are in the band, how many fewer students are not in the band?
8. Sarah has 85 marbles, and Tom has 62 marbles. How many more marbles does Sarah have than Tom?
9. There are 80 books in the library. If 25 books are mysteries and the rest are adventure books, how many more adventure books are there than mystery books?
10. Daniel has 120 baseball cards, and Jake has 98 baseball cards. How many more baseball cards does Daniel have than Jake?
