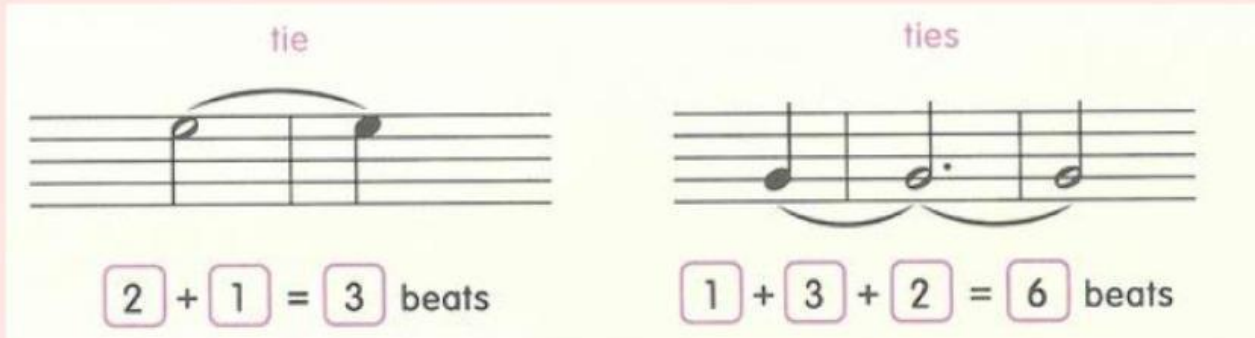


Tie

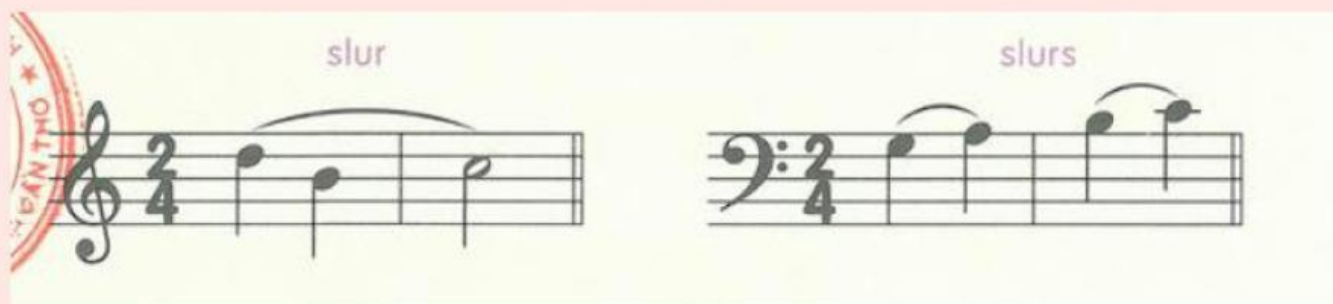
A tie connects 2 or more notes of the same pitch
The 1st note is played and held for the length of the tied notes

Slur
