1. What is a **clause**? A clause is a group of words in a sentence which contains a **subject** and a **verb**. It is a **complete thought**.

The price **is** too high.

2. What is a **phrase**? A phrase is a group of words in a sentence that **does not** contain both a subject and a verb. It is **not** a complete thought.
