pop (n) /pɒp/	modern music that is popular among young people	BTS is a great Korean pop group. They play beautiful music.
classical music (n phr.) /ˌklæsɪkəl 'mjuːzɪk/	a type of music that has a formal traditional style and lasting value	I enjoy listening to Beethoven's classical music .
rock (n) /rɒk/	a type of modern music in which performers use electric guitars and drums	Older people really don't like rock music .
country music (n phr.) /'kʌntri 'mjuːzɪk/	a type of music based on traditional southern US music, featuring singing, guitars, and violins	<i>Two Dozen Roses</i> is a lovely country music song.
jazz (n) /dʒæz/	a type of music with a strong beat and solo parts for performers	Saxophones and pianos are the key instruments in jazz .
hip hop (n) /'hɪp hɒp/	a type of popular dance music with a steady heavy beat and spoken lyrics	Hip hop is popular in the U.S.

Grammar

Present Simple

Form

Affirmative I/We/You/They/ **like** listening to jazz.
He/She/It/Mary **likes** listening to jazz.

Negative I/We/You/They/ **don't like** listening to jazz.
He/She/It **doesn't like** listening to jazz.

Questions **Does** he/she/it **like** playing games?
Yes, he/she/it **does**. / **No**, he/she/it **doesn't**.
Do we/you/they **like** listening to jazz?
Yes, we/I/they **do**. / **No**, we/I/they **don't**.

Usage

We use the **Present Simple** to talk about general preferences (likes and dislikes).

Pete **enjoys** listening to rock.

Ann **doesn't like** classical music.

Spelling rules of adding -s/es

For most verbs, we add **-s**.

like → likes
play → plays
enjoy → enjoys
listen → listens

For verbs ending in **-o, -s, -ch, -x, -sh, -z**, we add **-es**.

do → does
watch → watches
fix → fixes
finish → finishes

For verbs ending in **consonant + y**, change **y** to **ies**.

fly → flies
cry → cries
worry → worries
study → studies
