

# Ellis Island

**Be au preterit + V-en** (= participe passé)



1. First and second class passengers arriving in New York Harbor

2. However, regardless of class, sick passengers or those with legal problems  
\_\_\_\_\_ (send) to Ellis Island for further inspection.
3. Third class citizens steerage passengers would \_\_\_\_\_ (send) aboard a  
ferry to Ellis Island for their detailed inspection.
4. After the 1897 fire, the U.S. Treasury quickly ordered the  
immigration facility \_\_\_\_\_ (rebuild).
5. The new Main Building \_\_\_\_\_ (open) on  
December 17, 1900.
6. 2,251 immigrants \_\_\_\_\_ (receive) that day.
7. Annie Moore, a teenage girl from Ireland, accompanied by her two younger brothers, made
