INTENTION AND INVENTOR

When people invent, they are seeing a new way to solve their problems. Inventors often conceive a new idea and it can emerge when the inventor's focus is on something else, or while relaxing or sleeping. An innovative idea can come in a flash-a Eureka! moment. For example, after years of working on how to solve the general theory of relativity, its solution suddenly came to Einstein in a dream. Inventions can be also accidental, like in the case of polytetrafluoroethylene (Teflon). The invention process is often an exploratory one, with a result that can be uncertain or unknown. There are failures and successes too. Inspiration could start this process, but no matter how complete the initial idea is, they need to be fully developed. Inventors are often famous for their confidence, perseverance and passion. Ideas for inventions may be developed on paper or on a computer, by writing or drawing, by trial and error, by making models, by experimenting, by testing and/or by making the invention in its whole form. Brainstorming can also spark new ideas for an invention. Moreover, collaborative creative processes are frequently used by designers, architects and scientists.
