Space for All

As cities grow, they often take over land that is home to a wide variety of plant and animal species. However, there are companies that help protect these species, while still allowing humans to build. In Harmony is one such company. I spoke to their head of public relations, Patrick Lee, to find out more about their work.

Q: So, Patrick, tell me about In Harmony. What do you do?

PL: Basically, we work with local governments or companies whenever they want to build a new structure like a school or a shopping center. We help them develop a building plan that will protect local plants and animals.

Q: How can you both build and protect?

PL: When possible, we make sure building plans include enough space for plants and animals to continue to live and move around the new buildings. We also make sure soil and water sources are protected.

Q: What happens if there isn't enough space?

PL: When that happens, we find new homes for the plants and animals. We recently moved a large population of burrowing owls so a new school could be built. We found a location nearby and created new burrows in the ground for the birds to move into. This can add several months to a project, but the organizations we work with want to do everything they can to protect the wildlife.

Q: Wait, what's a burrowing owl?

PL: Oh, they're these tiny birds—well, tiny for an owl—that live in the ground. They're really interesting because they're active during the day, unlike most other owls. This actually made them easier for us to study and move for our last project. Our biologists didn't have to work at night.

Q: How do you know moving the animals and plants actually protects them?

PL: Any time we move an animal or plant population, we monitor it for six months, and then we check in once a year for several years after the project is finished. Last week, I went to check on a group of bobcats we moved two years ago. They were all healthy, and one even had two new kittens!"
