

1 Present Simple, Past Simple

Yesterday, she (go) to the store and (buy) some groceries.

My brother usually (play) video games in the evening, but yesterday he (read) a book.

2 Present Continuous vs Present Simple

The children usually (play) outside, but today they (watch) TV.

Look! It (rain) right now.

3 Past Simple vs Past Continuous

While I (work) on my project, my friend (call) me.

He (read) a book when the phone (ring).

4 Past Simple vs Present Perfect

I (visit) Paris two years ago, and I (never/be) there since.

She (just/finish) her homework.

5 Past Simple vs Past Perfect

By the time we (arrive), the train (leave).

He (tell) me that he (lose) his keys.
