# Famous twins

### Acting and politics

Actor Scarlett Johansson is from New York, USA. She acted for the first time in a theatre when she <sup>2</sup> ... eight years old. One year later she was in a film. She went to acting school in 2002 and is now famous all over the world for films like *Lost in Translation*, *Iron Man* and the *Captain America* series. But did you know that she has a twin brother called Hunter?

Hunter Johansson has <sup>3</sup> ... brown eyes and dark hair, Scarlett's eyes are green and she's got fair hair. Hunter often goes to 'red carpet' events with Scarlett.
