Basset Hounds

Basset Hounds are dogs which are famous for their sad eyes, long ears and short legs. Some of them have black tails and some have brown tails but all of them have white at the end of their tails. People first used them for hunting in France in the 1500s. The hunters did not need expensive horses because they could follow the dogs on foot. Bassets moved slowly and were quiet, so they did not scare away the rabbits which they chased. Bassets are good hunting dogs because of their amazing sense of smell. Only Bloodhounds can smell better than Bassets can.

In the 1780s, a Frenchman sent seven enormous Bassets to his friend, President George Washington, in America. In 1866, Bassets finally arrived in Britain. They became really popular a hundred years later when they appeared in TV adverts for shoes called *Hush Puppies*. There is also a famous cartoon Bassett called Fred, who has been in a newspaper comic strip for 50 years.

Bassets never do what people say. If you say 'Sit!', they will probably lie down. If you shout 'Come here!', they will probably run away. However, they are popular with families because they are gentle with children and love being with people. Bassett owners say that they are difficult but wonderful.
