



PAST SIMPLE -REGULAR VERBS-

Affirmative sentences

REGULAR VERBS CAN ADD:		
BASIC FORM: + ED	CHANGE Y AND + IED	+D
<i>Work - worked</i> <i>Clean - cleaned</i>	<i>Cry – cried</i> <i>Copy - copied</i>	<i>Love – loved</i> <i>Create - created</i>

We only use this form in AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES.

Example: I worked in my project yesterday.

We lived in London last year.

Negative sentences

-Use DIDN'T + verb (infinitive)



Example: You didn't listen to the radio yesterday

He didn't study Maths for the exam

Questions

-Use DID

- Did you study for the exam? Yes, I did / No, I didn't
- Did he travel to America last month? Yes, he did / No, he didn't
- What** did you use to type your essay? I used my laptop
- Where** did you study last Saturday? I studied at the library
- Who** did you visit? I visited my grandparents
