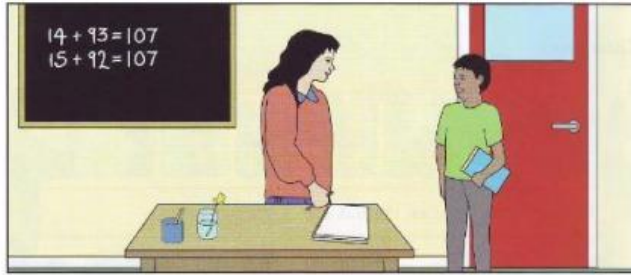

4. They sat and Q10.4..... for their Mum and Dad under some trees.



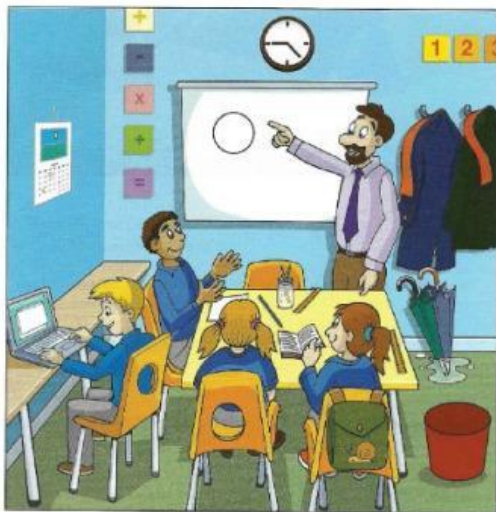
