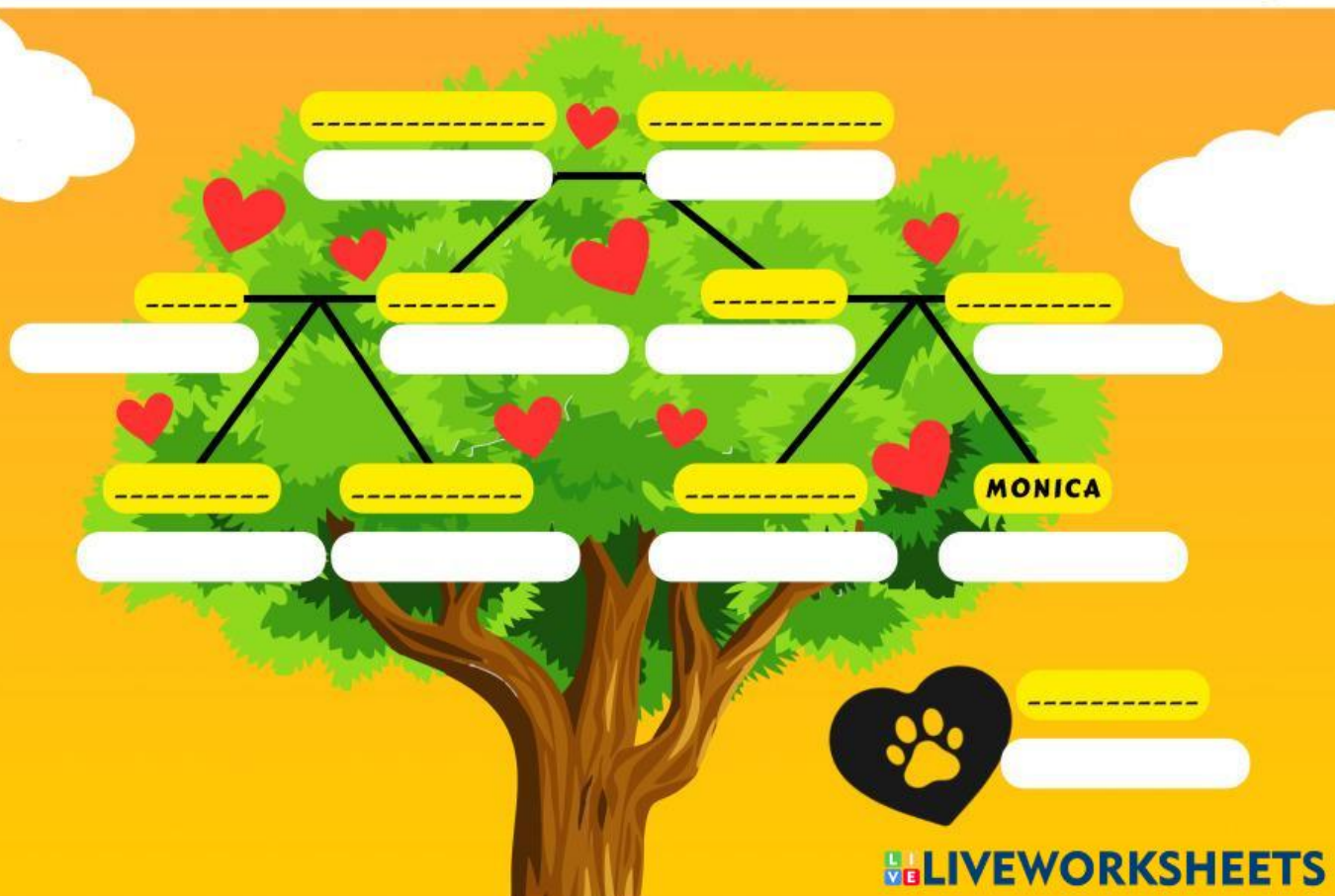
1. Reading:

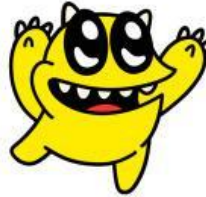
My grandmother's name is Julia and my grandfather's name is Roberto. They have white hair and green eyes. They are university professors.
