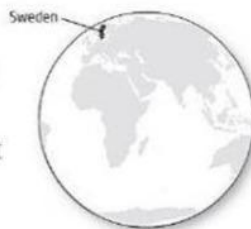

Celebrating the Sun

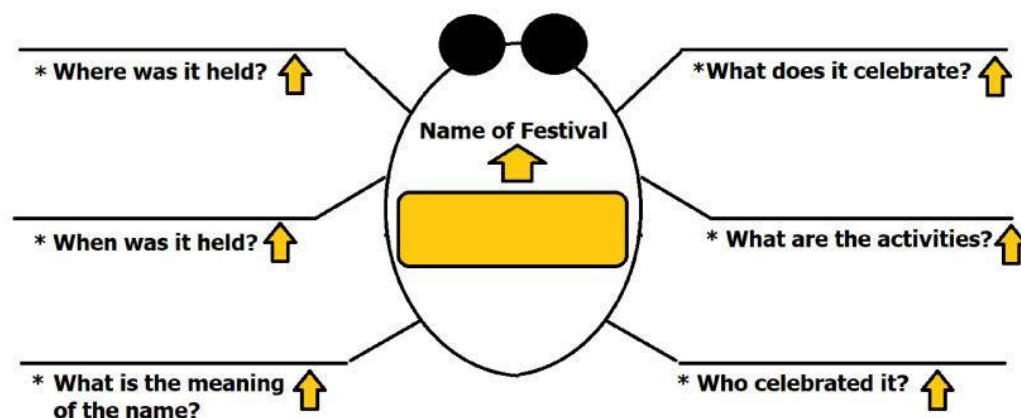
