Possessive adjectives

We use possessive adjectives to show who or what owns something.

My	dad	is a pilot.
Your	mum	is a police officer.
His	jacket	is blue.
Her	sister	is in my class.
Our	friends	are here.
Their	teacher	is kind.

Remember!

We put possessive adjectives before nouns:

Our house is small.

The pilot landed the plane **calmly**.
The chef carried the plates **carefully**.
Jenna **helpfully** tidied the classroom.
We went down the stairs very **slowly**.

We add 'ly' to most adjectives to make adverbs. But:

- happy – happily
easy – easily
good – well
