

a/an – the – one/ones

- We use **a/an** with singular countable nouns when we talk about them in general. **He asked for a cup of tea.**
- We use **the** with countable or uncountable nouns when we talk about something specific; that is, when the noun is mentioned for a second time or is already known.
I have a book in my bag. The book is very heavy.
- We use **the** with:
a) the names of: rivers (**the Seine**), seas (**the Red Sea**), oceans (**the Pacific**), mountain ranges (**the Alps**), deserts (**the Sahara**), groups of islands (**the Dodecanese**), museums/art galleries (**the Louvre**), unique places (**the Acropolis**), cinemas/theatres (**the Plaza**), musical instruments (**the guitar**), dances (**the flamenco**) and families (**the Beckhams**)
b) the superlative: (**the most beautiful girl**, she speaks **the most loudly**).
- We don't use **the** with:
a) the names of: countries (**Italy**), cities (**Madrid**), parks (**Hyde Park**), mountains (**Mount Everest**), individual islands (**Cyprus**), lakes (**Lake Victoria**), continents (**Africa**), streets (**Oxford Street**), months (**February**), celebrations (**New Year's Day**) meals (**dinner**)
b) fixed expressions (**go to school**, **by car/bus**, **on foot**).
- We use **one** in the singular and **ones** in the plural to avoid repeating a noun when it is clear what we mean.
